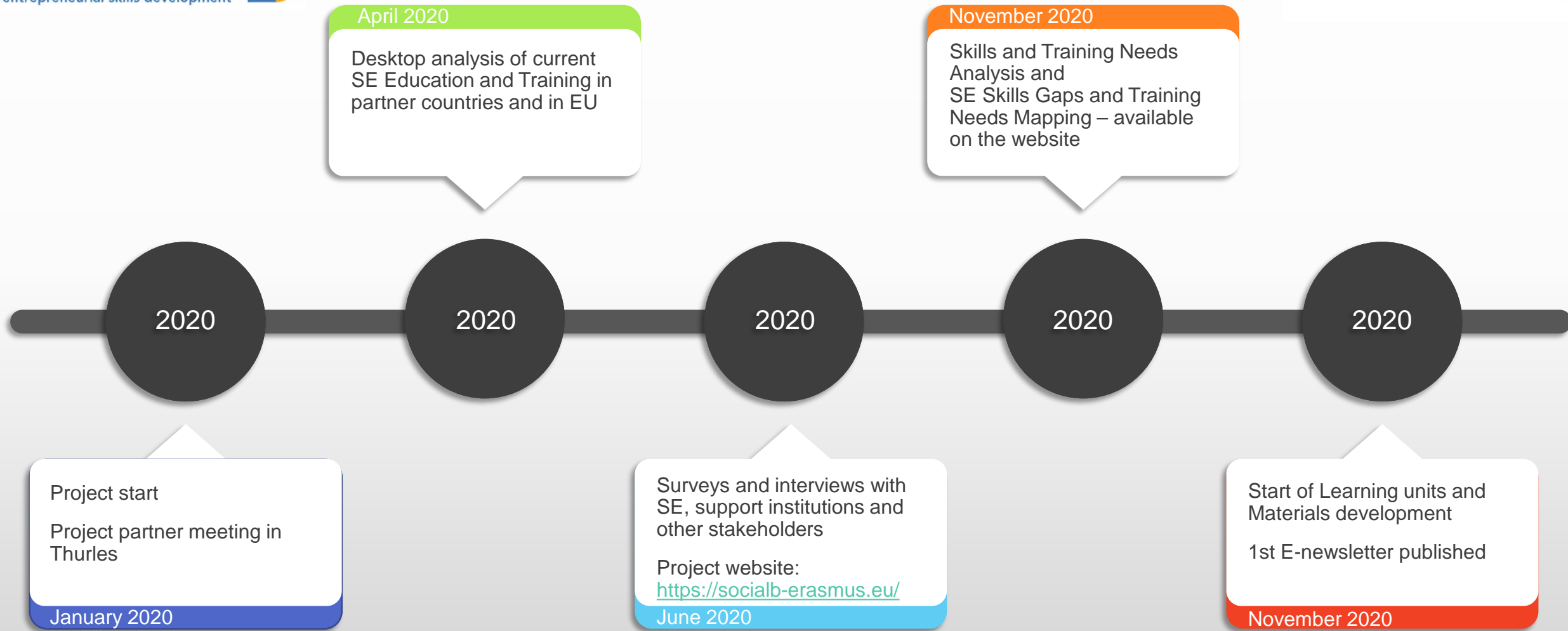
# *Learning resources*

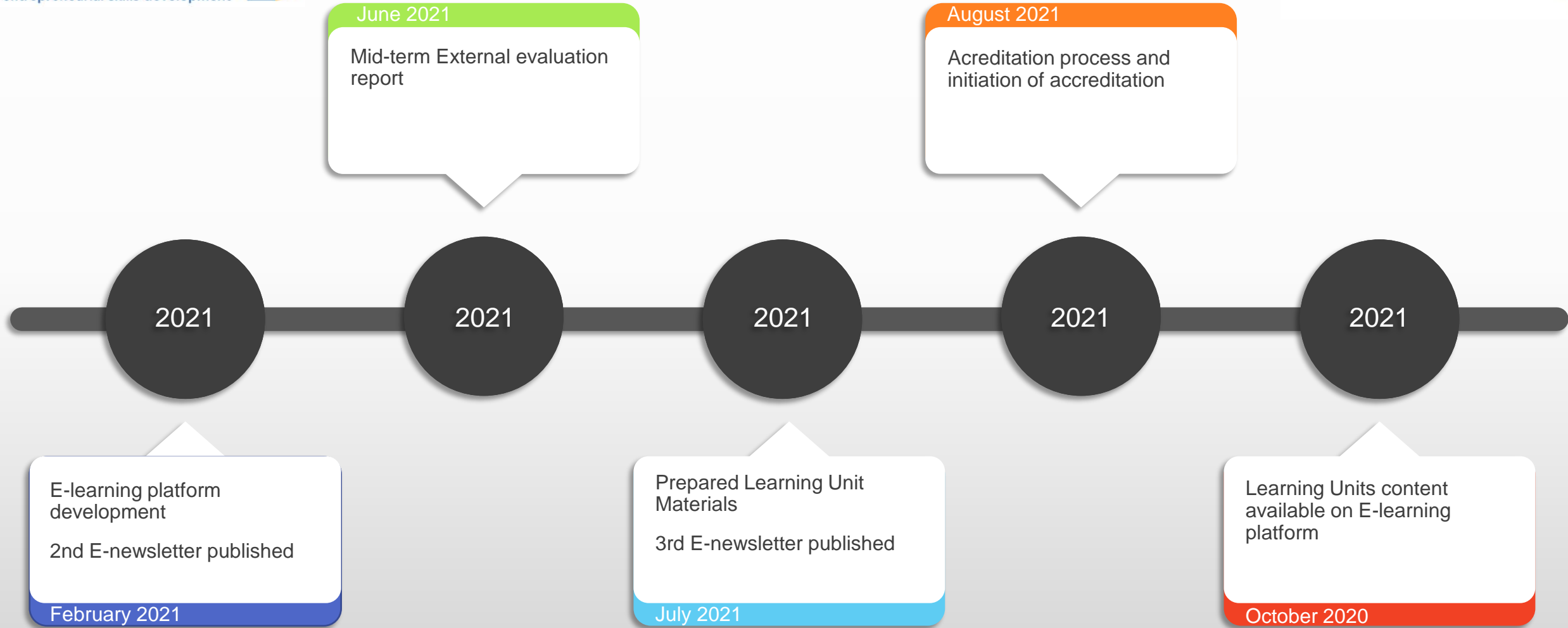
EQF Level of the resources: 5 and 6.



# SocialB project timeline 1/3

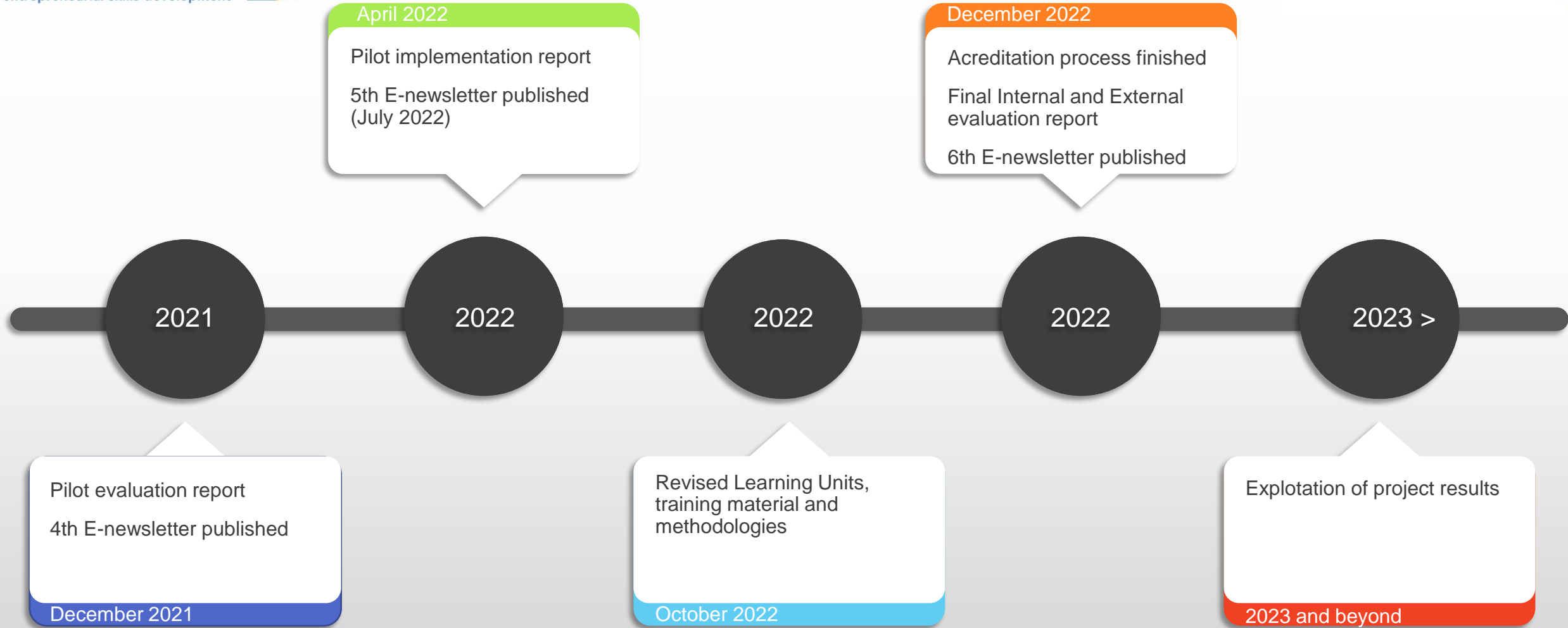


# SocialB project timeline 2/3
